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10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 56-585.4 as follows:
11 12	§ 56-585.4. Use of residential declining block rate schedules.
13	A. As used in this section:
14	"Declining block rate structure" means a rate structure in which the per-unit price of electricity
15	decreases as the amount of electricity consumed increases.
16	"Electric utility" means any investor-owned electric utility or electric cooperative.
17	B. In any proceeding initiated on or after July 1, 2013, under § 56-235.2, 56-585.1, or 56-585.3 or
18	any other section of this title in which the Commission is required to review the rates or tariffs of an
19	electric utility, the Commission shall not approve a rate schedule or tariff that utilizes a declining block
20	rate structure, including a seasonal declining block rate structure, for residential customers unless the
21	electric utility demonstrates that such a rate structure is equitable to all affected customers and
22	consistent with the Commonwealth's energy efficiency goals.
23	C. Nothing in this section shall prevent the Commission from approving a rate schedule or tariff that
24	utilizes (i) a declining block rate structure for customers in an industrial, commercial, or other
25	nonresidential class or (ii) an inclining block rate structure, flat block rate structure, or a combination
26	thereof, for residential customers.
