WHEREAS, on December 8, 2012, the Lake Taylor High School football team earned the school's first football state championship by winning the Virginia High School League Group AAA, Division 5 state championship; and

WHEREAS, the Lake Taylor Titans capped off an undefeated regular season with a dominant run in the playoffs, beating Phoebus High School in the Virginia High School League (VHSL) Eastern District final and North Stafford High School in the VHSL Group AAA Division 5 semifinal; and
