10	RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, a majority of the members elected to
11	each house agreeing, That the following amendment to the Constitution of Virginia be, and the same
12 13	hereby is, proposed and referred to the General Assembly at its first regular session held after the next general election of members of the House of Delegates for its concurrence in conformity with the
13 14	provisions of Section 1 of Article XII of the Constitution of Virginia, namely:
15	Amend Section 5 of Article VIII of the Constitution of Virginia as follows:
16	ARTICLE VIII
17	EDUCATION
18 19	Section 5. Powers and duties of the Board of Education. The powers and duties of the Board of Education shall be as follows:
20	(a) Subject to such criteria and conditions as the General Assembly may prescribe, the Board shall
$\overline{21}$	divide the Commonwealth into school divisions of such geographical area and school-age population as
22	will promote the realization of the prescribed standards of quality, and shall periodically review the
23	adequacy of existing school divisions for this purpose.
24 25	(b) It shall make annual reports to the Governor and the General Assembly concerning the condition and needs of public education in the Commonwealth, and shall in such report identify any school
23 26	divisions which have failed to establish and maintain schools meeting the prescribed standards of
27	quality.
28	(c) It shall certify to the school board of each division a list of qualified persons for the office of
29	division superintendent of schools, one of whom shall be selected to fill the post by the division school
30 31	board. In the event a division school board fails to select a division superintendent within the time prescribed by law, the Board of Education shall appoint him.
32	(d) It shall have authority to approve textbooks and instructional aids and materials for use in courses
33	in the public schools of the Commonwealth.
34	(e) Subject to such criteria and conditions as the General Assembly may prescribe, it shall have
35	authority to establish charter schools within the school divisions of the Commonwealth.
36 37	(f) Subject to the ultimate authority of the General Assembly, the Board shall have primary responsibility and authority for effectuating the educational policy set forth in this Article, and it shall
38	have such other powers and duties as may be prescribed by law.
