9	WHEREAS, the Second Amendment to the Constitution of the United States protects the individual
10	right to keep and bear arms; and
11	WHEREAS, the Supreme Court of the United States has found that the Second Amendment protects
12	the right of individuals to possess any bearable arm commonly used for lawful purposes in <i>District o</i>
13	Columbia v. Heller, applied to the states in McDonald v. Chicago; and
14	WHEREAS, some in Washington, D.C. have made clear their intent to press Congress for legislation
15	that would restrict the lawful acquisition and possession of firearms and ban many firearms commonly

used for self-defense, hunting, competition, and target shooting; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly hereby recognizes that the Second Amendment to the United States Constitution protects an individual right to keep and bear arms; and, be it
