8	WHEREAS, the YMCA of Arlington has helped provide valuable learning opportunities to students
9	as a loyal participant in the Virginia YMCA Model General Assembly program; and
10	WHEREAS, started in 1948, the Virginia YMCA Model General Assembly program (MGA) allows
11	high school students to gain firsthand insights into the legislative process by drafting and debating
12	pieces of mock legislation; and WHEPEAS over the past 65 years over 50,000 participants in the MCA have traveled to Dichmond
13 14	WHEREAS, over the past 65 years, over 50,000 participants in the MGA have traveled to Richmond and taken on the roles of senators, delegates, reporters, lobbyists, and officers; and
15	WHEREAS, partnering with the Governor's Career and Technical Academy in the Arlington Career
16	Center, the YMCA of Arlington first participated in the MGA in 2010; the partnership granted
17	underserved students the opportunity to learn more about government; and
18	WHEREAS, in 2010 and 2011, the YMCA of Arlington sent six students from the Arlington Career
19 20	Center to the MGA; and WHEPEAS are and in 2012, the
20 21	WHEREAS, expanding the program to include students from different backgrounds in 2012, the YMCA of Arlington invited five students from the Arlington Career Center and six from Yorktown
22	High School; and
23	WHEREAS, the YMCA of Arlington plans to invite students from the Arlington Career Center,
24	Yorktown High School, and at least one additional school to the 2013 MGA session; and
25	WHEREAS, students enter a training program in the fall to prepare for the MGA session, which
26 27	occurs after the completion of the Virginia General Assembly session; and WHEREAS, with the assistance of current members of the General Assembly, students research and
28	select bills, learn about the rules and responsibilities of the General Assembly, and practice debate
<b>29</b>	techniques and public speaking; and
30	WHEREAS, during the 2012 MGA session, the YMCA of Arlington team brought two bills, both
31	related to current issues, up for debate; and
32 33	WHEREAS, one of the bills, introduced by Benjamin Barsky of Yorktown High School, was passed and signed into law, marking the first time that the YMCA of Arlington team had successfully guided a
33 34	bill through the entire process; and
35	WHEREAS, several Yorktown High School students were named as officers for the 2013 session,
36	including Ellie McDonald as president pro tempore of the senate, Maddie Moran as sergeant-at-arms,
37	and Aisha Farooq as deputy clerk; and
38	WHEREAS, the MGA helps students build confidence, develop leadership skills, appreciate new
39 40	viewpoints, and gain valuable experience into the inner workings of the Commonwealth; now, therefore, be it
41	RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly hereby
42	commend the YMCA of Arlington for participating in the Virginia YMCA Model General Assembly
43	program; and, be it
44 45	RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the Senate prepare a copy of this resolution for
45 46	presentation to the YMCA of Arlington as an expression of the General Assembly's admiration for the club's dedication to providing learning opportunities for students in Arlington County.
