5 6 WHEREAS, Mosby Woods Elementary School in the City of Fairfax celebrates its 50th anniversary 7 in 2013; and 8 WHEREAS, Mosby Woods Elementary School was founded on September 3, 1963, on a historical 9 site associated with John S. Mosby, a United States Civil War commander; and WHEREAS, with a diverse, international student population from the Vienna and Fairfax areas, 10 Mosby Woods Elementary School promotes the value of multiculturalism in the strengthening of 11 American ideals; the 940 students at the school come over 40 different countries and speak 28 different 12 13 languages; and WHEREAS, a fully accredited learning institution, Mosby Woods Elementary School reports 14 15 accreditation pass rates of nearly 100 percent in all subjects; and WHEREAS, the teaching staff of Mosby Woods Elementary School uses early childhood education 16 17 techniques to ensure the best possible learning environment for students; and WHEREAS, offering programs with different approaches to learning, Mosby Woods Elementary 18 19 School is equipped to accommodate any type of learner; the high standards throughout the school 20 motivate all students to learn to think critically and creatively; and 21 WHEREAS, leading by example, the dedicated staff at Mosby Woods Elementary School strives to 22 instill the importance of respect, hard work, accountability, and honesty in each student; and 23 WHEREAS, providing a wide range of opportunities for students, Mosby Elementary School 24 provides mentoring and tutoring initiatives through Oakton High School and partners with Lockheed 25 Martin Corporation; and WHERÊAS, Mosby Woods Elementary School is known for its partnership with the Kennedy Center 26 27 for the Performing Arts and participates in the Changing Education Through the Arts program; and 28 WHEREAS, for the past 10 years, Mosby Woods Elementary School has focused on arts integration 29 in its curriculum; students have also engaged in many art and music programs, including classes and 30 performances; and 31 WHEREAS, Mosby Woods Elementary School offers many extracurricular activities and events, 32 including a chess club, a science club, foreign language programs, museum programs, Einstein night, 33 and a geography bee; and WHEREAS, Mosby Woods Elementary School encourages students to become involved in the 34 35 community through a service-oriented student government program; and 36 WHEREAS, displaying further involvement with parents and the community, Mosby Woods 37 Elementary School hosts a variety of programs, including a parent volunteer program, curriculum 38 meetings, social activities, and cultural arts events; and 39 WHEREAS, in the past nine years, through its Walk for the Homeless program, Mosby Woods Elementary School has raised over \$180,000 to benefit the homeless; and 40 WHEREAS, Mosby Woods Elementary School has won several awards, including the Title 1 41 Distinguished School Award in 2006 and 2007 for outstanding achievements on Virginia Standards of 42 Learning tests, the 2010 Virginia Board of Education Excellence Award, and the 2011 Virginia 43 44 Governor's Award for Educational Excellence; and WHEREAS, from 2005 to 2011, Mosby Woods Elementary School met adequate yearly progress 45 goals for No Child Left Behind in all subgroup populations; the school was also named as one of the 46 2012 "Best Elementary Schools" by Northern Virginia magazine; and 47 WHEREAS, Mosby Woods Elementary School serves the public by ensuring that the Fairfax area's 48 49 future leaders receive the best possible education; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly hereby 50 51 commend Mosby Woods Elementary School on the occasion of its 50th anniversary; and, be it 52 RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the Senate prepare a copy of this resolution for 53 presentation to Mahri Aste, principal of Mosby Woods Elementary School, as an expression of the General Assembly's admiration for the school's continuing tradition of academic excellence and 54 55 contributions to the community.
