4. Title: Overweight vehicle permits.

5. Summary: This bill allows the court to invalidate a standard overweight permit in circumstances where a super load permit was required.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary.

7b. Revenue Impact: See Item #8.

8. Fiscal Implications: Indeterminate. Fines collected on overweight load violations could increase substantially, but it is impossible to estimate how many carriers may be in violation of weight restrictions.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of Motor Vehicles; cities, towns, and the counties of Arlington and Henrico; and carriers hauling overweight loads in the Commonwealth to the extent that more permits could be invalidated.

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: No.

11. Other Comments: The Virginia Department of Transportation may experience more engineering reviews for overweight permits.
