**5. Summary:** Administration of medications by employees or contract service providers of providers licensed by the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services. Provides that employees of or persons providing services pursuant to a contract with a provider licensed by the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services may administer insulin, glucagon, and epinephrine in certain circumstances; provides protection from liability for certain acts related to such administration; and requires the Board of Nursing to promulgate regulations governing training in the administration of epinephrine by persons authorized to administer epinephrine.
