5. Summary: This bill provides specific examples regarding what constitutes the act of littering and offers an alternative penalty for individuals who litter in quantities no greater than 0.7 cubic feet in volume.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate (see Section 8)

8. Fiscal Implications: Currently, there is insufficient information available to reliably estimate the number of violations and the amount of revenue that could result from this proposed legislation. However, by giving violators a less expensive option than the current fines, resulting revenues could decrease over time. Any fines collected under these provisions would be deposited into the Literary Fund.
