3. Committee: House Committee on General Laws

4. Title: Alcoholic beverage control; mixed beverage licenses for certain properties

5. Summary: Authorizes the Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) Board to grant mixed beverage licenses to certain properties located in Smyth County, notwithstanding the outcome of the liquor-by-the-drink referendum in those jurisdictions.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary (see Item 8)

8. Fiscal Implications: Currently, there are eleven exemptions to the provisions of §4.1-124 listed under §4.1-126 of the Code of Virginia. This bill adds three additional exemptions. According to the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control, this bill has no material fiscal impact on its agency operations.
