2. Patron: Anderson

3. Committee: Passed both houses

4. Title: Comprehensive plan; transportation.

5. Summary: The proposed legislation amends the time period by which the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) shall provide comment on local transportation plans by allowing a shorter review period as agreed to by VDOT and the locality. The standard review period remains at 90 days.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: None.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The proposed legislation would allow for a shorter allotted review time of local transportation plans when the locality and VDOT agree on a shorter time. The provisions of the bill are not expected to impact state finances.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of Transportation, local governments.

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: None.

11. Other Comments: This bill is similar to SB1293, which is going to a conference committee. The House amended the bill to shorten the review period to 45 days and the Senate rejected the amendment.
