4. Title: Powers and duties of the Commonwealth's Attorneys' Services Council.

Summary: Requires the Commonwealth's Attorneys' Services Council to provide information on changes in the law that affect the duties and responsibilities of law enforcement officers and make such information available to law enforcement agencies, law enforcement training academies, and the Department of Criminal Justice Services.

Fiscal Implications: The Commonwealth's Attorneys Services Council (CASC), as a normal course of business, provides local prosecutors a training package that advises them of changes in the law and other pertinent information.
