- 5. Summary: Adds specific topics to be covered during the educational programs for governing boards and requires such programs to be delivered by the State Council of Higher Education annually. The bill also requires each board of visitors to adopt bylaws with certain provisions relating to the Freedom of Information Act; annually meet with the president of the institution to deliver a review of the president's performance; designate its executive committee to organize the working processes of the board and recommend best practices for board governance; and annually deliver an executive summary of its interim activities to the General Assembly and the Governor.
- **6. Budget Amendment Necessary**: Yes, funding was provided in Item 146.
- 7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final.
- **8. Fiscal Implications:** This legislation repeals §23-87.95 of the Code of Virginia and replaces it with HB1952ER. It outlines detailed extensive detailed responsibilities of the boards of visitors that must be completed in coordination with the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia. The General Assembly included \$50,000 in the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia budget for this purpose.
