3. Committee: Passed Both Houses.

4. Title: Use of electronic tracking devices; penalty.

5. Summary: Provides that any person who uses an electronic tracking device through intentionally deceptive means and without consent to track the location of another person is guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor. The bill includes exceptions.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: Although this legislation could have a possible additional revenue impact, it is impossible to determine the extent of the impact at this time. A Class 3 misdemeanor does not carry any jail time. The penalty for conviction is a fine up to \$500. All revenue from fines goes to the state's Literary Fund.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Court System.
