- **4. Title:** Unconventional vehicles.
- **5. Summary:** This bill provides for the titling and registration of mopeds and distinctive license plates for low-speed vehicles. The bill also requires a moped operator to carry government-issued photo identification and wear a face shield, safety glasses, or goggles if his moped is not equipped with safety glass or a windshield. Mopeds and all-terrain vehicles shall be assessed the motor vehicle sales and use tax only if there is no evidence of payment of a retail tax. The bill, too, replaces the term "scooter" with "foot-scooter" and makes other largely technical changes based upon recommendations made by the Department of Motor Vehicles after a year-long study of Virginia's laws relating to unconventional vehicles.
