**3. Committee:** Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural Resources

**4. Title:** Surface mining of coal.

**5. Summary:** This repeals an obsolete chapter in Title 45.1 that regulates the surface mining of coal. The provisions of this chapter have been superseded by the Virginia Coal Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act (§ 45.1-226 et seq.).

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** No Fiscal Impact.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** This bill simply repeals an obsolete portion of Title 45.1. This technical measure deletes an entire chapter of the Virginia Administrative Code, as there are no permits outstanding under Chapter 17.

**9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected:** Department of Mines, Minerals and Energy.

**10. Technical Amendment Necessary:** No.

**11. Other Comments:** This bill is part of the Governor's Regulatory Reform Initiative. SB1014 is the companion bill.
