4. Title: Workers' compensation; awards of compensation

5. Summary: Provides that wages paid to an employee who is physically unable to return to his pre-injury work due to a compensable injury and who is provided work within his capacity at a wage equal to or greater than his pre-injury wage shall be considered compensation paid pursuant to an award for compensation. Any award of compensation may be reviewed by the Workers' Compensation Commission.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of Human Resource Management indicates that while the provisions of this bill may impact the State Employee Workers Compensation Program, the fiscal impact if any, is indeterminate.
