Summary: This bill authorizes the Governor to request federal funds to construct a new veterans' care center in Northern Virginia, and requires the State Treasurer to issue a short-term treasury loan in an amount up to \$28.5 million for the state share of construction costs, once the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs has determined that federal funds will be

- 8. Fiscal Implications: This bill creates § 1 language that conforms with House Amendment C-34.15 #1h and Senate Amendment C-34.15 #1s regarding the availability of state matching funds for construction of a new veterans care center in the Northern Virginia area to comply with the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR). 38 CFR 59.50 and 38 CFR 59.70 require Virginia to certify, once it is determined that federal funds are to be allocated, that the project may proceed "without further action required by the state." While issuance of a treasury loan for the state share of construction costs satisfies the federal requirement for the immediate availability of project funding, action will be required by the Governor and General Assembly to determine the source of \$28.5 million in funding to repay the loan. Both houses have included the Northern Virginia Care Center in their amendments authorizing additional issuance of bonds for construction (C-39.40 #1h and C-39.40 #1s).
