4. Title: Mental health policies for State Board for Community Colleges

5. Summary: Requires the Board for Community Colleges to develop an awareness and referral policy including education efforts and school contact with local community services boards.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Virginia Community College System (VCCS), threat assessment teams have been implemented at each campus to provide educational awareness of mental health issues to students, faculty and staff and to prepare for and assess potential emergency situations to include requesting an assessment to determine whether a student, faculty, or staff member poses a threat of violence to self or others. Each institution has designated a point of contact for the local mental health community services board (CSB) to prepare for and respond to potential emergency situations, to include requesting an assessment to determine whether a student, faculty, or staff member poses a threat of violence to self or others, per state board policy.
