**3. Committee:** Privileges and Elections

**4. Title:** Voter registration; registration activities by third parties.

**5. Summary:** Requires individuals and groups conducting voter registration drives who receive 25 or more applications from the State Board of Elections to register with the State Board of Elections or local offices, provide information as required by the State Board, receive training, and execute a sworn affidavit that they will abide by all Virginia voter registration laws and rules. The bill also prohibits pre-populating registration applications with information unless directed by the applicant to do so, with an exception for DMV and other state-designated voter registration agencies. Finally, the bill reduces the time limit for mailing or delivering such completed applications from 15 to 10 days.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The State Board of Elections indicates that they currently provide training to groups conducting voter registration drives, therefore this legislation results in no significant fiscal impact to the agency.
