4. Title: Law enforcement officers; grounds for decertification.

5. Summary: Provides that no person who becomes a law enforcement officer on or after July 1, 2013, may have been convicted of or pled guilty or no contest to a Class 1 misdemeanor involving moral turpitude, any sex offense, or any domestic assault. Additionally, any certified law enforcement officer who has been convicted of or pled guilty or no contest to any such crime shall be decertified by the Criminal Justice Services Board.
