**4. Title:** Administrative Process Act; emergency regulations.

**5. Summary:** The bill: 1) lengthens the initial effective period of emergency regulations from 12 months to 18 months, and 2) adds a requirement that if the Governor chooses to exercise his authority to extend the effective period for up to an additional six months, it must be done before the initial 18-month period expires. The bill is a recommendation of the Virginia Code Commission.
