4. Title: Disposal of infectious waste.

5. Summary: This bill repeals certain provisions regarding the permitting of infectious waste incinerators by the State Air Pollution Control Board and the Waste Management Board. The repeal of these sections will eliminate outdated regulations, which have been superseded by federal air emission requirements.

The Virginia Waste Management Board's regulations related to medical waste incinerators would remain in place under the Board's other existing authorities.
