4. Title: Health insurance program for local government employees and other political subdivisions

5. Summary: The bill removes the authority of centers for independent living and area agencies on aging to join the Local Choice Plan for their employees. The bill also makes technical changes to remove obsolete provisions.

8. Fiscal Implications: The bill has no fiscal impact on the state health plan. It eliminates area agencies on aging and centers for independent living from including their employees in the Local Choice Plan. According to the Department of Human Resource Management the elimination of these private entities is necessary to ensure the Local Choice Plan is considered a governmental plan under the federal Employee Retirement Income Security Act (ERISA).
