3. Committee: Passed Both Houses

4. Title: Information Technology Advisory Council; chairmanship and meeting frequency.

5. Summary: The House substitute bill provides for the Information Technology Advisory Council to elect a chairman and vice-chairman from its membership. Under the bill, neither the Secretary of Technology nor the CIO may serve as chairman. Under current law, the Secretary of Technology serves as chairman and the Chief Information Officer serves as vice-chairman of the Council. The bill also removes the requirement for the Council to meet at least quarterly.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Virginia Information Technologies Agency (VITA) serves as staff to the ITAC and sees no fiscal impact to the Commonwealth.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: VITA, the Secretary of Technology, the Secretary of the Commonwealth, and the Secretary of Veterans Affairs and Homeland Security

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: No.

11. Other Comments: The bill is identical to House Bill 2082.
