- **4. Title:** Reckless driving; using a handheld communications device; penalty.
- **5. Summary:** Provides that the punishment for persons convicted of reckless driving that were using a handheld personal communications device for texting purposes during the reckless driving offense, shall incur a mandatory minimum fine of \$500. The legislation changes fines for first violations of texting while driving from \$20 to \$250, and second or subsequent offenses from \$50 to \$500.
