5. Summary: The proposed legislation requires the Department of Corrections to withhold child support payments out of moneys paid to prisoners who maintain a job within the department. Child support payments owed will also be withheld from any inmate trust account established for the prisoner.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of Corrections currently complies with court ordered child support and the Division of Child Support Enforcement obtains child support from prisoner accounts.
