3. Committee: Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources

4. Title: Nonmotorized vessels; freshwaters of State shall be open certain times for purposes of recreation.

5. Summary: This bill provides that the freshwaters of the Commonwealth shall be open to nonmotorized vessels for purposes of recreation between sunrise and sunset. This policy will apply regardless of whether the water body is deemed to be navigable or nonnavigable or whether the adjoining banks are publicly or privately owned.
