Fiscal Implications: The task force will be comprised of the Secretary of Commerce and Trade, the Director of the Department of Human Resources Management, the Tax Commissioner, the Commissioner of the Department of Labor and Industry, or their designees, and representatives of the Virginia Employment Commission, and the Virginia Workers' Compensation Commission, or their designees. Each of these agencies may incur costs in fulfilling their responsibilities under the provisions of the bill; however, any costs are expected to be minimal and absorbable within existing resources.

Some factors associated with changing classification may increase costs and others may decrease costs to the Commonwealth, but the overall impact of defining "employee" is unknown.
