3. Committee: Courts of Justice

4. Title: Smoking; unlawful for person to smoke in motor vehicle with minor present, civil penalty.

5. Summary: Provides that any person who smokes in a motor vehicle, whether in motion or at rest, when a minor under the age of 15 is in the motor vehicle is subject to a civil penalty of \$100. The offense may be charged on a uniform traffic summons.
