9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 15.2-5204 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 15.2-5204. Members of commission; quorum; compensation; expenses; removal and vacancies.
12	A. A hospital or health center commission shall consist of the following number of members based
13	upon the number of political subdivisions participating: for one political subdivision, five members; for
14	two, six members; for three, six members; for four, eight members; and for more than four, one member
15	for each of the participating subdivisions. The respective members shall be appointed by the governing
16	bodies of the subdivisions they represent, may be members of such governing bodies, may be residents
17	of such subdivisions, and shall be appointed for such terms as the appointing body designates. A
18	member shall hold office until the earlier of the effective date of his resignation or the date on which
19	his successor has been appointed and has qualified. Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term. The
20	powers of the commission conferred by this chapter shall be vested in and exercised by the members in
21	office. A majority of the members then in office shall constitute a quorum. The commission shall elect
22	its own chairman and shall adopt rules and regulations for its own procedure and government. The
23	commission members may receive up to \$50 for attendance at each commission meeting, not to exceed
24	\$1,200 per year, and shall be paid their actual expenses incurred in the performance of their duties. Any
25	commission member may be removed at any time by the governing body appointing him, and vacancies
26	on the commission shall be filled for the unexpired terms.

27 B. In Chesterfield County, the number of commission members shall be seven and their terms may be staggered as the appointing body designates. Such members shall not be removable at any time by 28

29 the County's governing body except for malfeasance or at the end of the member's term. HB1093
