The Virginia Commission on Youth shall make 13 recommendations for the modernization of Virginia's policies and regulations related to seclusion and 14 15 restraint in schools and submit its recommendations no later than November 30, 2014, to the General Assembly. The Virginia Commission on Youth shall report its findings to the Governor and the 2015 16 17 Regular Session of the General Assembly.
