| 10 | Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: |
| 11 | 1. That §§ 30-282 through 30-286 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows: |
| 12 | § 30-282. Virginia Transportation Solutions Working Group established; composition; terms; |
| 13 14 | compensation and expenses; quorum; voting on recommendations. There is hereby established in the legislative branch of state government the Joint Commission on |
| 15 | Transportation Accountability Virginia Transportation Solutions Working Group. The Commission |
| 16 | Working Group shall consist of six members of the House of Delegates appointed by the Speaker of the |
| 17 | House of Delegates, of whom at least three shall be members of the House Committee on |
| 18 19 | Transportation; four members of the Senate appointed by the Senate Committee on Rules of whom at least two shell be members of the Senate Committee on Transportation; and the Auditor of Public |
| 19 20 | least two shall be members of the Senate Committee on Transportation; and the Auditor of Public Accounts, who shall serve as a nonvoting ex officio member. Members shall serve terms coincident with |
| $\overline{21}$ | their terms of office as members of the House of Delegates and the Senate. Members may be |

| 23 24 | Members of the Commission Working Group shall receive such compensation as provided in § 30-19.12 and shall be reimbursed for all their reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in the |

| 26 | compensation and expenses of the members shall be provided from existing appropriations to the |

| 28 29 | The Commission Working Group shall annually elect a chairman and a vice-chairman from among its membership. Meetings of the Commission Working Group shall be held upon the call of the |
| <u>30</u> | chairman or whenever the majority of the members so request. A majority of the members appointed to |

| 33 34 | Administrative staff support shall be provided by the Office of the Clerk of the house of the General Assembly of which the Chairman of the Commission Working Group is a member. Legal, research, |
| 35 | policy analysis, and other services as requested by the Commission Working Group shall be provided by |
| 36 | the Division of Legislative Services. Technical assistance shall be provided by the Joint Legislative |
| 37 38 | Audit and Review Commission upon request. § 30-284. Powers and duties of Working Group. |

| 40 | 1. To make performance reviews of operations of state agencies with transportation responsibilities to |
