7 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

8 **1. That § 4 of Chapter 726 of the Acts of Assembly of 1990, as amended by Chapters 642 and 675**
9 **of the Acts of Assembly of 1999, is amended and reenacted as follows:**

10 **§ 4. Members.**

11 The Authority shall consist of fourteen members, unless increased as provided for herein, who are to
12 be appointed or shall serve as follows:

13 1. One member to be appointed by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Charles City, Virginia,
14 and the sheriff of the County;

15 2. One member to be appointed by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Chesterfield, Virginia,
16 and the sheriff of the County;

17 3. One member to be appointed by the City Council of the City of Colonial Heights, Virginia, and
18 the sheriff of the City;

19 4. One member to be appointed by the City Council of the City of Hopewell, Virginia, and the
20 sheriff of the City;

21 5. One member to be appointed by the City Council of the City of Petersburg, Virginia, and the
22 sheriff of the City;

23 6. One member to be appointed by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Prince George,
24 Virginia, and the sheriff of the County; and

25 7. One member to be appointed by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Surry, Virginia, and
26 the sheriff of the County.

27 No member of the governing body of the County of Chesterfield, the County of Charles City, the
28 City of Colonial Heights, the City of Hopewell, the City of Petersburg, the County of Prince George, or
29 the County of Surry may be a member of the Authority.

30 All nonsheriff members of the Authority shall serve for a term of four years. The initial term of
31 office shall extend from the organizational meeting of the Authority until the Authority's annual meeting
32 four years thereafter. Any nonsheriff member of the Authority may be appointed to succeed himself.
33 Each duly appointed nonsheriff member shall hold office until his successor shall be duly appointed.
34 Any vacancy in the nonsheriff membership of the Authority, whether caused by expiration of term of
35 office, death, resignation, or otherwise, shall be filled by the governing body of the city or county which
36 appointed the member whose membership is then vacant. Any member appointed to fill an unexpired
37 term shall serve only until the expiration of the term he was appointed to fill. Sheriffs shall serve a term
38 coexistent with their term as sheriff.

39 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, special or general, alternate members may be appointed
40 to the Authority by the governing body of the city or county in the same manner as regular members,
41 *except that sheriffs may appoint their own alternates.* If a regular member is not present at the meeting
42 of the Authority, the alternate for that member shall have all the voting and other rights of a regular
43 member and shall be counted for purposes of determining a quorum at any meeting. ~~Alternates may not~~
44 ~~be appointed for the sheriff members of the Authority.~~
