2 An Act to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 19.2-389.2, relating to background
 3 checks of applicants of the Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority.

6 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

7 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 19.2-389.2 as follows:

§ 19.2-389.2. Background checks of applicants of the Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority.
9 The police department of the Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority as established in Chapter
10 (§ 5.1-152 et seq.) of Title 5.1 may require an applicant, upon conditional offer of employment with
11 the Authority, to submit to fingerprinting and to provide personal descriptive information to be
12 forwarded along with the applicant's fingerprints through the Central Criminal Records Exchange and
13 the Federal Bureau of Investigation for the purpose of obtaining criminal history record information
14 regarding such applicant.

15 The Central Criminal Records Exchange, upon receipt of an applicant's record or notification that 16 no record exists, shall make a report to the chief of the police department of the Authority or his 17 designee, provided the designee is an employee of the police department of the Authority. In determining 18 whether a criminal conviction directly relates to a position, the Authority shall consider the following 19 criteria: (i) the nature and seriousness of the crime; (ii) the relationship of the crime to the work to be 20 performed in the position applied for; (iii) the extent to which the position applied for might offer an 21 opportunity to engage in further criminal activity of the same type as that in which the applicant had 22 been involved; (iv) the relationship of the crime to the ability, capacity, or fitness required to perform 23 the duties and discharge the responsibilities of the position being sought; (v) the extent and nature of 24 the applicant's past criminal activity; (vi) the age of the applicant at the time of the commission of the 25 crime; (vii) the amount of time that has elapsed since the applicant's last involvement in the commission 26 of a crime; (viii) the conduct and work activity of the applicant prior to and following the criminal 27 activity; and (ix) evidence of the applicant's rehabilitation or rehabilitative effort while incarcerated or 28 following release.

If an applicant is denied employment because of information appearing in his criminal history
record, the Authority shall notify the applicant that information obtained from the Central Criminal
Records Exchange contributed to such denial. The criminal history record information obtained pursuant
to this section shall be used solely to determine an applicant's eligibility for employment by the
Authority and access to restricted areas of Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport and Washington
Dulles International Airport in compliance with 49 U.S.C. § 44936 and shall otherwise be confidential.

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
