10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 22.1-212.27 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 22.1-212.27. Students enrolled in online courses and virtual programs.
13	A. Any student enrolled in any online course or virtual program offered by a local school division
14	shall be enrolled in a public school in Virginia as provided in § 22.1-3.1.
15	B. A student's parent or guardian shall give written permission prior to the enrollment of the student
16	in any full-time virtual program offered by a local school division.
17	C. A student shall not be charged tuition for enrolling in any online course or virtual program
18	offered by the school division in which he resides, pursuant to § 22.1-3. However, tuition may be
19	charged to students who do not reside within the boundaries of the school division offering such course
20	or program, pursuant to § 22.1-5. Each school division in which all elementary and secondary schools
21	are fully accredited shall offer its online courses and virtual school programs tuition-free or at one-third

of the normal tuition rate to students who do not reside within the boundaries of the school division and
who attend public elementary or secondary schools that are not fully accredited.
