10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 1. That §§ 33.1-1 and 33.1-2 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 33.1-1. State Highway and Transportation Board continued as Commonwealth Transportation
13	Board; number and terms of members; removal from office; Commonwealth Transportation
14	Commissioner continued as Commissioner of Highways; vacancies.
15	The State Highway and Transportation Board, formerly known as the State Highway and
16	Transportation Commission, is continued and shall hereafter be known as the Commonwealth
17	Transportation Board. Wherever either "Commission" or "Board" is used in this title referring to the
18	State Highway and Transportation Board or the State Highway and Transportation Commission, it shall
19	mean the Commonwealth Transportation Board.
20	The Board shall consist of 18 members: the Secretary of Transportation, the Commissioner of
21	Highways, the Director of the Department of Rail and Public Transportation, the Executive Director of
22	the Virginia Port Authority, and 14 citizen members. The citizen members shall be (i) appointed by the
23	Governor as provided in § 33.1-2, (ii) subject to confirmation by the General Assembly, and (iii)
24	removable from office during their respective terms by the Governor at his pleasure. Appointments of
25	citizen members shall be for terms of four years commencing upon July 1, upon the expiration of the
26	terms of the existing members, respectively. The initial terms of the members appointed in January, 1087 shall commence when empirited and shall be for terms anding June 20, 1088. June 20, 1080, and
27 28	1987, shall commence when appointed and shall be for terms ending June 30, 1988, June 30, 1989, and June 30, 1990, respectively. Vacancies shall be filled by appointment by the Governor for the unexpired
20 29	term and shall be effective until 30 days after the next meeting of the ensuing General Assembly and, if
<b>3</b> 0	confirmed, thereafter for the remainder of the term. No person shall be eligible to serve more than two
31	successive terms of four years, other than the Secretary of Transportation, the Commissioner of
32	Highways, the Director of the Department of Rail and Public Transportation, and the Executive Director
33	of the Virginia Port Authority. A person heretofore or hereafter appointed to fill a vacancy may serve
34	two additional successive terms.
35	If the number of congressional districts is increased through redistricting, the Governor shall appoint
36	a member to the Board from the newly created district. If a congressional district is lost through
37	redistricting, the Governor shall remove the member from the lost congressional district. The addition or
38	subtraction of the congressional member shall be from the membership of the at-large members. The
39	effective date of revision in membership shall be July 1 of the year in which the district was created or
40	lost. The Secretary of Transportation shall some as Chairman of the Doord. The Secretary shall have

<b>48</b>	and Transportation Board" is used, it shall mean "Commonwealth Transportation Board"; "State
<b>49</b>	Highway Commissioner" or "State Highway and Transportation Commissioner" or "Commonwealth
50	Transportation Commissioner" shall mean Commissioner of Highways; and all references to "Department
51	of Highways and Transportation" shall refer to the Department of Transportation.

53	Of such Board, one member shall be a resident of the territory now included in the Bristol

The at-large members shall be appointed to represent 64 rural and urban transportation needs and be mindful of the concerns of seaports and seaport users, airports and airport users, railways and railway users, and mass transit and mass transit users. Each 65 member so appointed shall be mindful of the best interest of the Commonwealth at large primarily 66 67 instead of those of the district from which chosen or of the transportation interest represented.

68 2. That nothing in this act shall affect the term of any member appointed to the Commonwealth
