10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. § 1. The Department of Health shall convene a work group consisting of representatives from the
12	Department; the Board for Waterworks and Wastewater Works Operators and Onsite Sewage System
13	Professionals; the Board for Architects, Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors, Certified Interior
14	Designers and Landscape Architects; private sector engineering and design firms; and other interested
15	stakeholders identified by the Department to (i) identify and examine any engineering and design
16	services related to the design of onsite septic systems currently offered by the Department to the public
17	that are in inappropriate direct competition with private sector engineering and design firms, (ii) define
18	the role of the Department in services related to the design of onsite septic systems to avoid
19	inappropriate direct competition, (iii) develop a plan to wind up services offered by the Department
20	deemed to be in inappropriate direct competition, and (iv) identify any necessary legislative or
21	regulatory changes to implement the plan. The work group shall report its findings and
22	recommendations to the General Assembly and the Board of Health by October 1, 2014.
