2 *An Act to amend and reenact § 3.2-6552 of the Code of Virginia, relating to the killing of a dog*
3 *chasing or injuring livestock or poultry.*

6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

7 **1. That § 3.2-6552 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 **§ 3.2-6552. Dogs killing, injuring or chasing livestock or poultry.**

9 It shall be the duty of any animal control officer or other officer who may find a dog in the act of
10 killing or injuring livestock or poultry to *seize or* kill such dog forthwith whether such dog bears a tag
11 or not. Any person finding a dog committing any of the depredations mentioned in this section shall
12 have the right to kill such dog on sight as shall any owner of livestock or his agent finding a dog
13 chasing livestock on land utilized by the livestock when the circumstances show that such chasing is
14 harmful to the livestock. Any court shall have the power to order the animal control officer or other
15 officer to kill any dog known to be a confirmed livestock or poultry killer, and any dog killing poultry
16 for the third time shall be considered a confirmed poultry killer. The court, through its contempt powers,
17 may compel the owner, custodian, or harbinger of the dog to produce the dog.

18 Any animal control officer who has reason to believe that any dog is killing livestock or poultry
19 shall be empowered to seize such dog solely for the purpose of examining such dog in order to
20 determine whether it committed any of the depredations mentioned herein. Any animal control officer or
21 other person who has reason to believe that any dog is killing livestock, or committing any of the
22 depredations mentioned in this section, shall apply to a magistrate serving the locality wherein the dog
23 may be, who shall issue a warrant requiring the owner or custodian, if known, to appear before a
24 general district court at a time and place named therein, at which time evidence shall be heard. If it
25 shall appear that the dog is a livestock killer, or has committed any of the depredations mentioned in
26 this section, the district court shall order that the dog be: (i) killed immediately by the animal control
27 officer or other officer designated by the court; or (ii) removed to another state that does not border on
28 the Commonwealth and prohibited from returning to the Commonwealth. Any dog ordered removed
29 from the Commonwealth that is later found in the Commonwealth shall be ordered by a court to be
30 killed immediately.
