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10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That §§ 54.1-2911 and 54.1-2912 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 54.1-2911. Board; membership; terms of office; executive director.
13	The Board of Medicine shall consist of one medical physician from each congressional district, one
14	osteopathic physician 12 allopathic or osteopathic medical physicians, one podiatrist, one chiropractor,
15	and four <i>nonlegislative</i> citizen members. No two <i>nonlegislative</i> citizen members shall reside in the same
16	congressional district. Citizen Nonlegislative citizen members shall have all voting and participation
17	rights of other members. The term of office of the members of the Board shall be four years. If any
18	medical physician member of the Board ceases to reside in the district from which he was appointed,
19	except by reason of redistricting, his office shall be deemed vacant.
20	The officers of the Board shall be a president, a vice-president, and a secretary, who shall also act as
21	treasurer, who all of whom shall be members of and selected by the Board.
22	Regular meetings of the Board shall be held at such times and places as prescribed by the Board.
$\overline{23}$	Special meetings may be held upon the call of the president and any 11 members. Twelve members of
24	the Board shall constitute a quorum.
25	The Board may establish an executive committee composed of the president, <i>the</i> vice-president, the
2 6	secretary, and five other members of the Board appointed by the president. The executive committee
2 7	shall include at least two <i>nonlegislative</i> citizen members. In the absence of the Board, the executive
28	committee shall have full powers to take any action and conduct any business authorized by this chapter.
2 9	Five members of the executive committee shall constitute a quorum. Any actions or business conducted
3 0	by the executive committee shall be acted upon by the full Board as soon as practicable.
31	There shall be an executive director for the Board of Medicine who shall be licensed or eligible for
31 32	licensure in the Commonwealth as a physician.
32 33	§ 54.1-2912. Nominations.
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	Nominations for appointment to the Board may be made for the allopathic or osteopathic medical
35	physicians from a list of three names submitted to the Governor by the Medical Society of Virginia and
36	the osteopathic physician, and podiatrist and chiropractor members, respectively, from a list of at least
37	three names of candidates submitted by June 1 of each year by their respective state societies. The
38	Board shall evaluate all candidates for nomination based on their individual competencies and medical
39	specialties and shall recommend candidates for nomination to the Governor. In evaluating candidates
40	for nomination, the Board shall consider the competencies and specialties of the current members of the
41	Board and the need for inclusion of individuals representing specific competencies and specialties on the
42	Board to allow the Board to fulfill its obligations. In no case shall the Governor be bound to make any
43	appointment from among the nominees of the respective societies. The Governor may notify the society,
44	which may make nominations, of any professional vacancy other than by expiration among the members
45	of the Board representing the particular profession and like nominations may be made for the filling of
46	the vacancy.

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
