Adultery defined; civil penalty. 11 12 Any person, being married, who voluntarily shall have sexual intercourse with any person not his or 13 her spouse shall be is guilty of adultery, punishable as a Class 4 misdemeanor and subject to a civil penalty of not more than \$250. Any attorney for the Commonwealth of the county or city in which an 14 15 alleged violation occurred may bring an action to recover the civil penalty and the proceeds shall be deposited into the Literary Fund. Any law-enforcement officer may issue a summons for a violation of 16

17 this section.
