Commending Good Shepherd Housing and Family Services, Inc. Patron—Surovell; Senator: Ebbin

6 WHEREAS, Good Shepherd Housing and Family Services, Inc., marks 40 years of working to 7 reduce homelessness, increase community support, and promote the potential for self-sufficiency among the working poor in Fairfax County; and 8

WHERĚÂS, in 1974, a group of volunteers from a local church helped a couple and their eight 9 10 children locate safe and suitable housing, marking the beginning of Good Shepherd Housing, whose mission continues today; and 11

WHEREAS, the award-winning programs developed by Good Shepherd Housing serve Fairfax 12 County residents who have been denied housing in their own names; the organization provides rental 13 14 housing for its clients and teaches people the skills and discipline needed to improve their credit history 15 and financial situation; and

WHEREAS, in the last four decades, Good Shepherd Housing has helped tens of thousands of people 16 in southeastern Fairfax County; the organization received a Washington Post Award for Excellence in 17 18 Nonprofit Management in 2013; and

19 WHEREAS, Good Shepherd Housing was presented the 2012 Board Leadership Award from the 20 Center for Nonprofit Advancement; and

WHEREAS, the Fairfax County Chamber of Commerce named Good Shepherd Housing the 2012 21 22 Nonprofit of the Year; and

23 WHEREAS, Good Shepherd Housing for 40 years has continued to provide housing search 24 assistance, financial counseling for low-income families and individuals, and a rich array of children's 25 activities that serve young people's educational, recreational, and social needs; and

WHEREAS, the staff of Good Shepherd Housing works closely with other area agencies that serve 26 27 Fairfax County's less fortunate citizens, including FACETS; Housing and Community Services of 28 Northern Virginia, Inc.; New Hope Housing; Cornerstones, formerly known as Reston Interfaith; Shelter 29 House, Inc.; and other organizations; now, therefore, be it

30 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly hereby 31 commend Good Shepherd Housing and Family Services, Inc., on the occasion of its 40th anniversary; 32 and, be it

33 RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates prepare a copy of this resolution 34 for presentation to Good Shepherd Housing and Family Services, Inc., as an expression of the General 35 Assembly's admiration for its many years of work to provide housing for less fortunate citizens of the 36 Commonwealth.
