6	Designating the Carillon Advisory Committee, in 2014, as the World War I 100th Anniversary
7	Committee in Virginia.
8	WHEREAS, World War I, originally known as the Great War, wrought significant and lasting
9	changes on the entire world between 1914 and 1918; with over 37 million casualties, it was one of the
10	deadliest conflicts in human history; and
11	WHEREAS, in the 1920s, the General Assembly of Virginia formed a commission to determine how
12	to best honor the men and women who served and sacrificed for their country during World War I; and
13	WHEREAS, the majestic Virginia War Memorial Carillon (the Carillon) was completed in 1932 and
14	dedicated to the Commonwealth in remembrance of the "patriotism and valor of the soldiers, sailors,
15	marines, and women from Virginia" who served in World War I; and
16	WHEREAS, the Carillon Advisory Committee was established by the City Council of Richmond to
17	ensure the maintenance and continued operation of the Carillon; and
18	WHEREAS, over the years, the members of the Carillon Advisory Committee have generously
19 20	donated their time and talents and succeeded in their mission to preserve the Carillon; and
20	WHEREAS, today, the Carillon remains one of the premiere historic landmarks in the City of
21	Richmond; and
22	WHEREAS, the Carillon Advisory Committee continues to honor those who served in World War I
23	by hosting Memorial Day and Veterans Day events at the Carillon; the nationally renowned Richmond
24	Community Nativity Pageant is also held at the Carillon every December 23; and
25	WHEREAS, in 2014, many countries, states, and communities will hold memorial services and
26	events to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the start of World War I; and
27	WHEREAS, having demonstrated a tireless dedication to honoring the veterans of World War I, the
28	members of the Carillon Advisory Committee are the ideal choice to lead the Commonwealth's World
29	War I 100th Anniversary memorial services in 2014; and
30	WHEREAS, the Carillon Advisory Committee take steps to ensure that any monuments, plaques,
31	displays, events, or services related to the World War I anniversary memorial reflect the patriotism,
32	honor, and valor, of all Virginians who served in World War I on an equal basis; now, therefore, be it
33	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly designate
34	the Carillon Advisory Committee, in 2014, as the World War I 100th Anniversary Committee in
35	Virginia; and, be it PESOLVED FURTHER . That the Clark of the House of Delegates transmit a conv of this resolution

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates transmit a copy of this resolution to the Carillon Advisory Committee so that the members of the Committee may be apprised of the sense of the General Assembly of Virginia in this matter. 36 37 38
