4	A BILL to amend and reenact § 37.2-406 of the Code of Virginia, relating to the location of methadone
5	clinics near schools and day care centers; exemptions for existing facilities and providers.

9 10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 37.2-406 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 37.2-406. Conditions for initial licensure of certain providers.
13	A. Notwithstanding the Commissioner's discretion to grant licenses pursuant to this article or any
14 15	Board regulation regarding licensing, no initial license shall be granted by the Commissioner to a provider of treatment for persons with opiate addiction through the use of methadone or other opioid
16	replacements, if the provider is to be located within one-half mile of a public or private licensed day
17	care center or a public or private K-12 school, except when such service is provided by a hospital
18 19	licensed by the Board of Health or the Commissioner or is owned or operated by an agency of the Commonwealth.
20	B. No provider shall be required to conduct, maintain, or operate services for the treatment of
21	persons with opiate addiction through the use of methadone or other opioid replacements on Sunday
22 23	except when such service is provided by a hospital licensed by the Board of Health or the Commissioner or is owned or operated by an agency of the Commonwealth, subject to regulations or
23 24	guidelines issued by the Department consistent with the health, safety and welfare of individuals
25	receiving services and the security of take-home doses of methadone or other opiate replacements.
26	C. Upon receiving notice of a proposal for or an application to obtain an initial license from a
27 28	provider of treatment for persons with opiate addiction through the use of methadone or other opioid replacements, the Commissioner shall, within 15 days of the receipt, notify the local governing body of
29	and the community services board serving the jurisdiction in which the facility is to be located of the
30	proposal or application and the facility's proposed location.
31 32	Within 30 days of the date of the notice, the local governing body and community services board shall submit to the Commissioner comments on the proposal or application. The local governing body
33	shall notify the Commissioner within 30 days of the date of the notice concerning the compliance of the
34	applicant with this section and any applicable local ordinances.
35 36	D. No license shall be issued by the Commissioner to the provider until the conditions of this section have been met, i.e., local governing body and community services board comments have been received
37	and the local governing body has determined compliance with the provisions of this section and any
38	relevant local ordinances.
39 40	E. No applicant for a license to provide treatment for persons with opiate addiction through the use of methadone or other opioid replacements that has obtained a certificate of occupancy in accordance
41	with the law and regulations in effect on January 1, 2004, shall be required to comply with the
42	provisions of this section with respect to the existing facility for which the certificate of occupancy was
43 44	<i>obtained</i> . No existing licensed provider shall be required to comply with the provisions of this section in any city or county with respect to an existing facility in which it is currently providing such treatment.
45	License applicants and licensees who fall within this exception shall, however, be required to comply
46	with the provisions of this section for purposes of relocating an existing facility or establishing a new
47 48	<i>facility.</i> F. The provisions of subsection A shall not apply to the jurisdictions in Planning District 8.
-10	1. The provisions of subsection is shall not apply to the jurisdictions in Flamming District 6.
