| 10 | Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: |
| 11 | 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 37.2-308.1 as follows: |
| 12 | § 37.2-308.1. Acute psychiatric bed registry. |
| 13 | A. The Department shall develop and administer a web-based acute psychiatric bed registry to |
| 14 | collect, aggregate, and display information about available acute beds in public and private inpatient |
| 15 16 | psychiatric facilities and public and private residential crisis stabilization units to facilitate the |
| 10 | identification and designation of facilities for the temporary detention and treatment of individuals who meet the criteria for temporary detention pursuant to § 37.2-809. |
| 18 | B. The acute psychiatric bed registry created pursuant to subsection A shall: |
| 19 | 1. Include descriptive information for every public and private inpatient psychiatric facility and every |
| 20 | public or private crisis stabilization unit in the Commonwealth, including contact information for the |
| 21 | facility; |
| 22 | 2. Provide real-time information about the number of beds available at each facility and, for each |
| 23 | available bed, the type of patient that may be admitted, the level of security provided, and any other |
| 24 | information that may be necessary to allow employees or designees of community services boards and |
| 25 26 | employees of psychiatric facilities to identify appropriate facilities for detention and treatment of individuals who meet the criteria for temporary detention; and |
| 20 27 | 3. Allow employees and designees of community services boards and employees of psychiatric |
| 28 | facilities to perform searches of the registry to identify available beds that are appropriate for the |
| 29 | detention and treatment of individuals who meet the criteria for temporary detention. |
| 30 | C. Every state facility, community services board, behavioral health authority, and private provider |
| 31 | licensed by the Department shall participate in the acute psychiatric bed registry established pursuant to |
| 32 | subsection A and shall designate an employee to submit information for inclusion in the acute |
| 33 | psychiatric bed registry and serve as a point of contact for addressing requests for information related |
| 34 35 | to data reported to the acute psychiatric bed registry. Information reported to the acute psychiatric bed |
| 35 | registry shall be updated at least daily. |

D. The Commissioner may enter into a contract with a private entity for the development and 37 administration of the acute psychiatric bed registry established pursuant to subsection A. ldtitle>

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
