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10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11 12	1. That § 2.2-2238 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: § 2.2-2238. Economic development services.
13	A. It shall be the duty of the Authority to encourage, stimulate, and support the development and
14	expansion of the economy of the Commonwealth. The Authority is charged with the following duties
15	and responsibilities to:
16 17	1. See that there are prepared and carried out effective economic development marketing and promotional programs;
18	2. Make available, in conjunction and cooperation with localities, chambers of commerce, industrial
19	authorities, and other public and private groups, to prospective new businesses basic information and
20 21	pertinent factors of interest and concern to such businesses;
$\frac{21}{22}$	3. Formulate, promulgate, and advance programs throughout the Commonwealth for encouraging the location of new businesses in the Commonwealth and the retention and growth of existing businesses;
23	4. Encourage and solicit private sector involvement, support, and funding for economic development
24 25	in the Commonwealth; 5 Encourage the accordination of the according development offerts of public institutions, regions
25 26	5. Encourage the coordination of the economic development efforts of public institutions, regions, communities, and private industry and collect and maintain data on the development and utilization of
27	economic development capabilities;
28	6. Establish such offices within and without the Commonwealth that are necessary to the expansion
29 30	and development of industries and trade; 7. Encourage the export of products and services from the Commonwealth to international markets;
31	8. Advise, upon request, the State Board for Community Colleges in designating technical training
32	programs in Virginia's comprehensive community colleges for the Community College Incentive
33 34	Scholarship Program pursuant to § 23-220.4; and 9. Offer a program for the issuance of export documentation for companies located in Virginia
35	exporting goods and services if no federal agency or other regulatory body or issuing entity will provide
36	export documentation in a form deemed necessary for international commerce.
37 38	B. The Authority shall prepare a specific plan annually that shall serve as the basis for marketing high unemployment areas of Virginia. This plan shall be submitted to the Governor and General
	Assembly annually on or before November 1 of each year. The report shall contain the plan and
40	activities conducted by the Authority to market these high unemployment areas. The annual report shall
41 42	be part of the report required by § 2.2-2242. C. The Authority shall develop a program by which local industrial parks may become certified by
<b>4</b> 3	the Commonwealth. In developing such a program, the Authority shall consider factors such as
44	planning, zoning, engineering, title ownership, and general development readiness. The program shall
45	also certify developments in various categories of industry, such as food preparation service facilities,
46	advanced manufacturing, and others as appropriate.
