6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 9.1-112 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**8 **§ 9.1-112. Committee on Training; membership.**

9 There is created a permanent Committee on Training under the Board that shall be the policy-making
10 body responsible to the Board for effecting the provisions of subdivisions 2 through 17 of § 9.1-102.
11 The Committee on Training shall be composed of 14 15 members of the Board as follows: the
12 Superintendent of the Department of State Police; the Director of the Department of Corrections; *the*
13 *Director of the Department of Juvenile Justice*; a member of the Private Security Services Advisory
14 Board; the Executive Secretary of the Supreme Court of Virginia; two sheriffs representing the Virginia
15 State Sheriffs Association; two representatives of the Chiefs of Police Association; the active-duty
16 law-enforcement officer representing police and fraternal associations; the attorney for the
17 Commonwealth representing the Association of Commonwealth's Attorneys; a representative of the
18 Virginia Municipal League; a representative of the Virginia Association of Counties; a regional jail
19 superintendent representing the Virginia Association of Regional Jails; and one member designated by
20 the chairman of the Board from among the other appointments made by the Governor.

21 The Committee on Training shall annually elect its chairman from among its members.
