11 12	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 33.1-70.02 as follows:
	§ 33.1-70.02. Maintenance and preservation of unpaved rural road network in Loudoun County.
13 14	In carrying out maintenance and preservation of unpaved rural roads in Loudoun County, the
14	Department of Transportation shall: 1. Maintain all unpaved roads in safe and usable condition;
13 16	2. Maintain unpaved roads in state and usable condition, 2. Maintain unpaved roads in traditional alignment, surface treatment, and width and protect banks,
17	stone walls, and roadside trees in all rural, agricultural, and historic areas;
18	3. Make improvements to selected sections of unpaved roads to reduce severe maintenance problems,
19	when needed, without significantly altering the roads' appearance or alignment and avoiding paving and
20	widening;
21	4. Only consider paving when there is a combination of very high traffic volume, significant
22	maintenance and safety issues, no historic or scenic significance, and clear community support for
23	paving;
24	5. Apply the Department's rustic road policies in any paving program in rural, agricultural, or
25	historic areas;
26	6. Focus limited paving resources primarily on highly traveled roads in developed areas; and
27	7. Make use of all available resources to support proper maintenance and preservation of the

28 unpaved rural road network in Loudoun County.
