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10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 46.2-873.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 46.2-873.1. Maximum speed limit on nonsurface-treated highways.
13	The maximum speed limit on nonsurface-treated highways, which are roads that are comprised of an
14	earth-aggregate or aggregate surface (i.e., dirt and gravel) that have not been stabilized with a
15	bituminous or cementitious material, shall be 35 miles per hour. The maximum speed limit upon such
16	highways may be increased or decreased by the Commissioner of Highways or other authority having
17	jurisdiction over highways. However, such increased or decreased maximum speed limit shall be
18	effective only when indicated by sign on the highway. For such highways upon which maximum speed
19	limit is not indicated by sign, the maximum speed limit shall be 35 miles per hour.
20	The provisions of this section shall apply in the Counties of Albemarle, Clarke, Fauquier, Frederick,

20 The provisions of this section shan apply in the Countes of Arbeinarie, Clarke, Fauquier, Frederick,
21 Loudoun, Montgomery, Nelson, Page, Rappahannock, Warren, and Wythe and in any other county
22 wherein the governing body adopts an ordinance pursuant to the provisions of this section.
