10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 16.1-279.2 and by adding
12	in Chapter 9.1 of Title 19.2 a section numbered 19.2-152.12 as follows:
13	§ 16.1-279.2. Hearing to grant protective order to be heard simultaneously with pending criminal
14	action.
15	Whenever practical, a court having jurisdiction over both a petition for a preliminary protective
16	order pursuant to § 16.1-253.1 or a protective order pursuant to § 16.1-279.1 and a pending criminal
17	action in which the defendant is also the respondent to the protective order and the victim of the crime
18	is also the petitioner for the protective order shall hear both actions simultaneously.
19	To achieve the purposes of this section, a preliminary protective order may be extended until the
20	conclusion of the criminal action.
21	Upon request of any party or upon its own motion, the court may bifurcate the actions for good
22	cause shown.
23	§ 19.2-152.12. Hearing to grant protective order to be heard simultaneously with pending criminal
24	action.
25	Whenever practical, a court having jurisdiction over both a petition for a preliminary protective
26	order pursuant to § 19.2-152.9 or a protective order pursuant to § 19.2-152.10 and a pending criminal
27	action in which the defendant is also the respondent to the protective order and the victim of the crime
28	is also the petitioner for the protective order shall hear both actions simultaneously.
29	To achieve the purposes of this section, a preliminary protective order may be extended until the
